(B3: MELK3), a homebuilder and developer with strategic focus in the South Region of Brazil and conducting operations in real estate and urban development projects, discloses its preliminary non-audited data concerning launches, gross and net sales, and deliveries of the third quarter of 2024 IN 9M2024, launches totaled R\$ 843 million (%Melnick), a 15 % decrease over the figures reported in 2023. SoS of Launches in 3Q24 reached 53%.

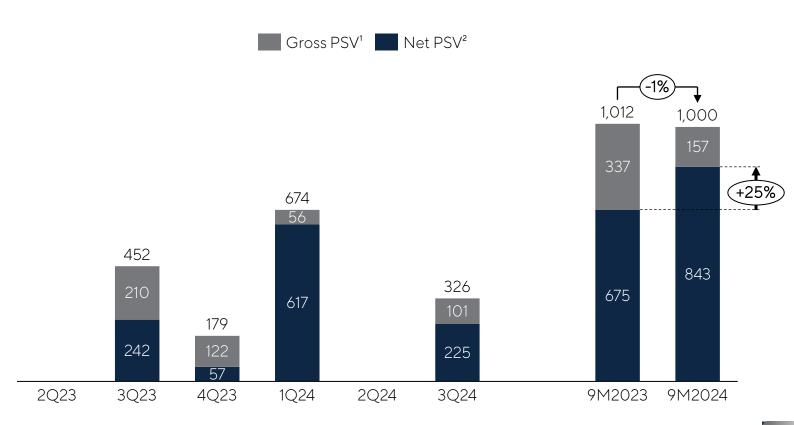


Launches

In the third quarter of 2024, we launched four developments in the amount of R\$ 326 million in gross PSV (R\$ 225 million % Melnick): In 9M2024, launches totaled R\$ 1 billion in gross PSV (R\$ 843 million % Melnick), a 25% growth (PSV Melnick) in relation to the same period of the previous year. Launches in the year (%Melnick) account for 115% of the volume launched in 2023 (R\$ 732 million, % Melnick).

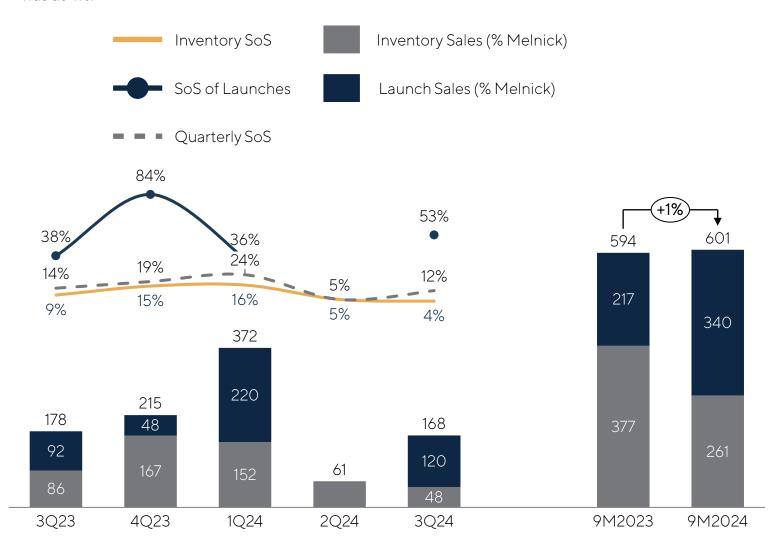


Sales

In the third quarter of 2024, gross and net sales totaled R\$ 182 million and R\$ 168 million (% Melnick), respectively. In 9M2024, gross and net sales totaled, respectively, R\$ 710 million and R\$ 601 million (% Melnick), a 1% growth in net sales when compared to the same period of the previous year.

Sales over inventory (SoS) of launches was at 53%, average SoS was at 12%, and SoS of inventory was at 4%.



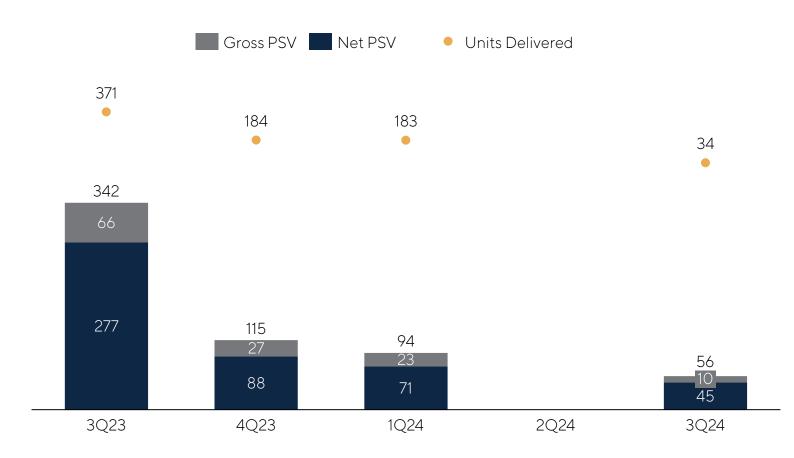
